

ROVERS & RANGERS PHOTO COLLAGE COMPETITION

(As per Nipun Training Scheme & Five Rocks of Rovering)

Objective of the Competition

The Photo Collage Competition is conducted to encourage Rovers and Rangers to creatively express the ideals of the Scout & Guide Movement, based on the Five Rocks of Rovering prescribed in the Nipun (Advanced) Training Scheme. The competition promotes character building, service, discipline, creativity, and active citizenship.

Theme – Five Rocks of Rovers & Rangers

Participants must base their collage on any one or more of the following Five Rocks: Character, Health, Service, Handicraft, and Hobby. The selected Rock(s) must be clearly depicted and explained in the collage.

Eligibility

- Open only to registered Rovers & Rangers
- Individual participation only
- Participants must adhere to Rover/Ranger age norms

Rules for Photo Collage Preparation

- Only one photo collage per participant is permitted
- Collage must contain 3 to 6 original photographs
- Internet or AI-generated images are strictly prohibited
- Basic editing such as cropping and brightness adjustment is allowed
- Each collage must include a title, mentioned Five Rock(s), and a 50–80 word description

Upload Guidelines

- Upload destination: Official Google Drive Folder shared by organizers
- File format: JPEG / PNG / PDF
- Maximum file size: 10 MB
- File naming format: UnitName_ParticipantName_Rover/Ranger
